



Endearment of the Heart: Habib Umar Bin Hafidh

Eligibility:

This event is especially for converts to Islam* and non-Muslims. If anyone outside of these categories purchases a ticket to the event and does not meet the eligibility criteria, they will not gain admission, nor will a refund be issued. Please see below for children.

* Born Muslim partners of Muslim converts/non-Muslims are also welcome.

Registration and Payment:

People should complete the registration process ASAP to ensure a place. Please note, places are limited and places for this event are expected to sell out very quickly. There are two ways to register and pay for this event:

1. Online. in advance through www.endearment.eventbrite.com where a variety of payment methods are available. Tickets are limited. This method is recommended to secure a place. The cost for booking in advance using this method is £20 per ticket.
2. On the day. There will be NO guarantee of places, nor will it be possible to reserve places by this method. Please contact us close to the event date to confirm that this method is still possible. If you plan on turning up on the day the cost of tickets is £30 per ticket.

Further assistance is available to those who cannot afford the price of tickets and find it difficult to cover the cost. We have links with several New Muslim Projects and other organisations in the UK and we can in certain circumstances request such organizations to sponsor the cost of tickets.

If, after paying and registering a person has to cancel or doesn't attend, then the full cost will be required from them, unless somebody else eligible can attend in their place.

Location:

Islamic Foundation, Markfield Conference Centre, Ratby Lane, Markfield, Leicestershire, LE67 9SY

Transport:

At junction 22 of the M1, take the A50 towards Leicester. The Markfield Conference Centre is sign-posted from the A50. After about 1.5 miles, at the next roundabout, take the third exit which is Launde Road, leading to Ratby Lane. The Markfield Conference Centre/Markfield Institute of Higher Education is on the left after a further half mile.
